Prayer List

3. Pray for the spiritual climax in Indonesia. They have embraced Islam as their major religion. Pray that the people will not be so blinded and the Light of God will reveal Himself to them.
4. Pray for the Christians in Indonesia that they will unite their hearts and to serve Him with integrity and passions for the expansion of His kingdom.

10. Pray for the teachers. Pray that God will give St Andrew's School Batam a Chinese teacher. The right person will come forward to take on the teaching baton to impact the children and the health of the teachers.
11. Pray for our year-end graduation concert, that God will help us to get all the training done and the children will be cooperative. Parents will not look at the end product but the process that the children had during the preparation.
12. Pray for our mission team in December to St Andrew's School Batam. That the team will have enough preparation to take on the task. The team will make good use of the platform to tell the parents of God and will have a strong bond as they work together for outreach.
13. Pray for the receptiveness of the heart of the parents as well as the guests. Pray that God will speak to the hearts of those who are present and they will appreciate the goodness of our God.
14. Pray for the overall people that we are reaching out to. Pray that they will have a receptive hearts and the people will open their hearts to God.
15. All the work cannot be done if not for Jesus. Pray that everyone (staff, parents of the children, mission teams, as well as people who are involved in the church ministries) can have a personal encounter with God.
