### **Missions – ACROSS**

#### **Who is ACROSS?**

The Anglican Crisis Relief Outreach and Support, Singapore (ACROSS) was set up in 2002 as a crisis relief ministry of the Diocesan Mission Board of the Diocese of Singapore. The objective for ACROSS is to offer a Christian response to the people affected by natural crisis (e.g. earthquakes, tsunamis, typhoons, severe winters, droughts, etc.). Through our help we hope to share God's love to them.

#### **Our Calling**

In the physical realm, we offer relief in practical ways (food, water, shelter, medical aid, etc.) and in the spiritual realm we offer hope that is found in Jesus Christ.

#### **Current on Going Responses (2009-2010):**

##### **MYANMAR (Cyclone Nargis) – S\$800K**

Reconstruction work has begun since 2009. To-date a total of 75 houses were completed. Second phase have just begun to build another 75 houses targeting to complete by early 2011. This relief work is hard work and your continued prayers for this nation are greatly appreciated.

##### **HAITI (Earthquake) – S\$150K**

ACROSS appreciates the contribution of about S\$150,000 from the parishes towards the Haiti Earthquake. The money has been channeled to our partner who provides both food & shelter relief work in Haiti.

##### **PADANG, INDONESIA (Earthquake) – S\$150K**

ACROSS appreciates the contribution of about S\$150,000 from the parishes towards the Padang Earthquake. The money has been channeled to the several Christian groups for both food & shelter relief work in Padang & surrounding areas.

##### **Mt. Sinabung, Medan INDONESIA (Volcano Eruption)**

ACROSS has send team from Singapore partnering a local NGO to provide food & children program to victims there.

##### **PESHAWAR/PUNJAB, PAKISTAMN (Flood) – S\$100K**

ACROSS appreciates the contribution of about S\$100,000 from the parishes towards Pakistan flood victims. Two medical teams were formed and send to provide medical aids, water purification system to 5 communities. The teams have ministered to about 1700 patients. Money were also channeled to the several Christian groups for provide relief work in Peshawar, Punjab & its surrounding areas.

#### **Continue Prayers for:**

- Victims in the following on-going crisis situations:
  - Mt. Sinabung volcano eruption in Beratagi, Sumatra
  - Flood in West Papua New Guinea
  - Mt. Merapi volcano eruption in Jogjakarta
  - Tsunami in Mentawai Islands, Sumatra
  - Partners continue work helping flood victims in Pakistan
  - Partners providing food & medical aid to earthquake victims in Haiti
- Closer networking with local and overseas partners (both existing & new).
- Volunteers (both existing & new) continue involvement in our existing/future projects.
- Continuous financial support from members and well-wishers from the Diocese, local & overseas support.
- Pray for our Lord's grace and wisdom be upon the task force/teams.
