For those drifting away in your relationship with God, may you return to the God of hope.

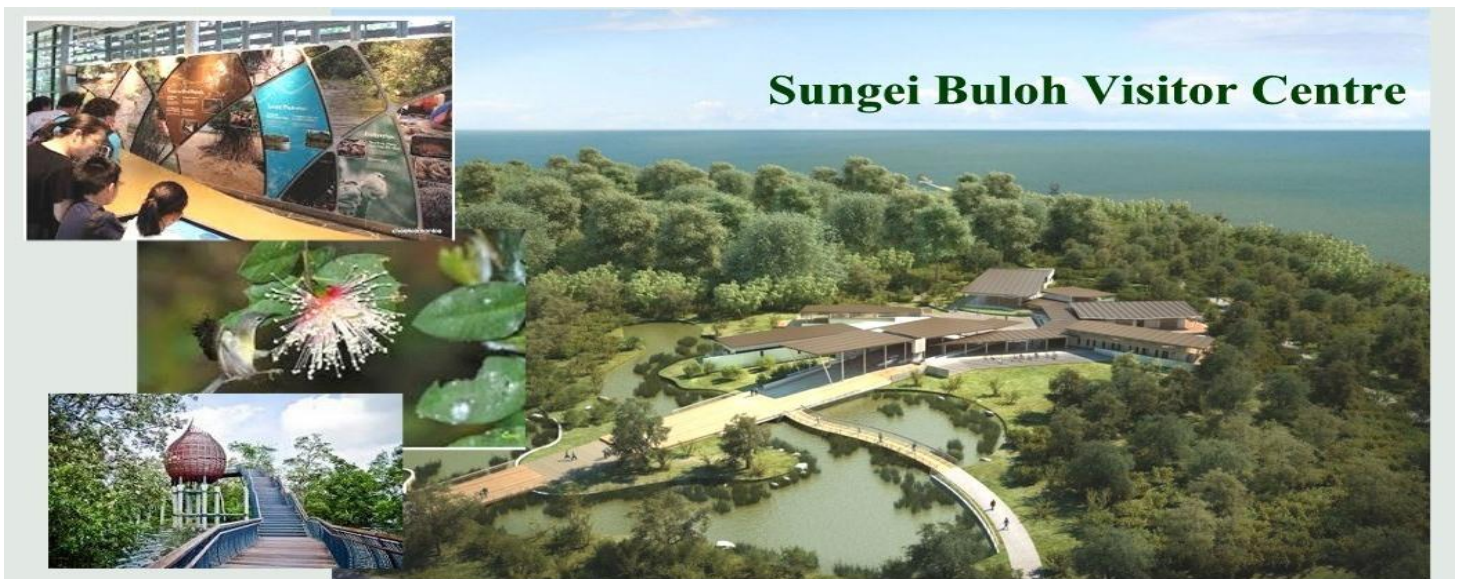
