Vicar writes

Dear church family

When we were young curious children, we may ask some questions as we observed the world around us. For example, how is it possible for a big heavy plane to fly in the air. Or we may wonder how can it be that a huge metal ship can float on the waters. As we study science and the environment, we begin to learn and understand the physical world better. We may ask, "How did life on earth begin?" or "Who created this world?"

When we grew older, we start to ask more important questions about life. There are three common questions.

Firstly, about our **Identity** – "Who am I?".

Secondly, about our **Purpose in life** – "Why was I born? Why am I here on earth?".

Thirdly, about our **Destiny** – "Where am I going when I die?".

The Bible provides the answers to these three important questions in life.

- "*Who am I?*" – We are loved and created in the image of God. When we believe in Jesus Christ our Saviour, we become the children of God.
- "*What is my purpose in life?*" – We worship and glorify God and enjoy God's love, and to share the good news of Jesus Christ.
- "*Where am I going when I die?*" – We have an eternal home in heaven in the presence of our loving Abba Father.

Singapore Anglican Community Services (SACS) St. Andrew's Mission Hospital (SAMH)

This Sunday, 24 June is designated as SACS-SAMH Sunday. Currently, they have a total of 27 centres serving some 20,000 people yearly in Singapore.

Thank God for:

- ❖ The dedication and commitment of the professional staff, volunteers, and chaplains together with the parishes to care for the needy amongst us. We believe God has called us to seek the welfare of the city through our community services rooted in Christian faith.
- ❖ Under the leadership of the anchor parish, their chaplains who are members of the care team provide pastoral, priestly and prophetic ministry in the centres.

Chaplaincy is part of the church ministry and hence not funded by public donation. Their total 2018 Chaplaincy budget is \$775,000 (SAMH- \$559,000, SACS-\$216,000) of which over 90% is manpower cost. The ratio of the funding need is about 2/3 SAMH and 1/3 SACS. Your generous giving to the Chaplaincy Fund will help them to fulfil our roles in the community services.
