Indonesia: The World's Largest Muslim Nation

Indonesia is an archipelago of over 13,500 islands divided into 27 provinces. The people of Indonesia represent hundreds of languages and cultures and religions. From lush rice fields to active volcanic slopes, from deserted beaches to crowded city streets.

Rapid urbanisation has meant that now an estimated 40% of the entire population live in massive cities particularly on the island of Java with Jakarta, Surabaya and Jogjakarta.

There are literally thousands of villages and towns throughout Indonesia that are 100% Muslims with no Christian witness. Yet, particularly in the cities, there are large churches and the Body of Christ is growing rapidly.
