WHITSUNDAY 9 JUNE 2019 – TOWARDS THE MINISTRY IN THE HORN OF AFRICA

The Diocese of Egypt is responsible for Anglican ministry in the Horn of Africa (comprising 4 countries - Ethiopia, Somalia, Eritrea and Djibouti). Bishop Kuan Kim Seng was recently asked to provide leadership for this responsibility. Although he serves as the Bishop's Commissary for Ethiopia, on an honorary basis, there are naturally other financial costs to bear, as they seek to develop the current ministry into two dioceses. Prayers and financial support for this 'Macedonian call' to our Diocese are greatly appreciated. The 2019 Whitsunday Offering would be given to support the ministry in the Horn of Africa, particularly so in Ethiopia, where Anglican ministry to the rest of the Horn of Africa is anchored.
